God is Just:

Justice = getting what you deserve

Read Leviticus 10:1-2. Was God just in punishing Nadab and Abihu? Why or why not?

God was just. As priests, they knew how they were supposed to offer incense. God had commanded them not to offer any incense other than what He had prescribed (Ex. 30:9-10). By offering unauthorized fire, they openly rebelled against God. They knew what He commanded, but chose to do it their own way.
