4) Our own lives:

-How has God been faithful to you in the past?

*Answers will vary*

Examples of God's faithfulness:

1) God is faithful to provide for our needs. (Psalm 37:25; Matthew 6:31-33;

Philippians 4:19)

2) God is faithful to comfort us during times of trial and temptation. (James 1:12 ; 1

Corinthians 10:13; Revelation 2:10)

3) God is faithful to forgive us of our sins. (Ephesians 1:7; 1 John 1:9;)

4) God is faithful to save us. (Philippians 1:6; 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24)
