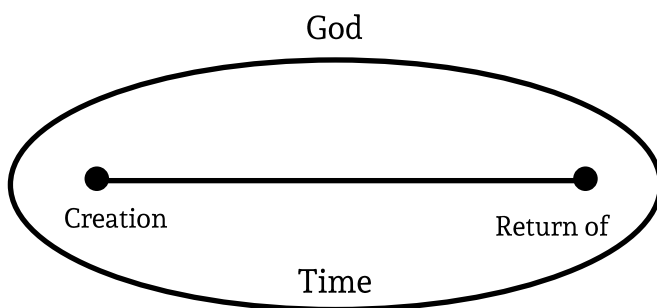

God is not shaped by time or a slave to time.

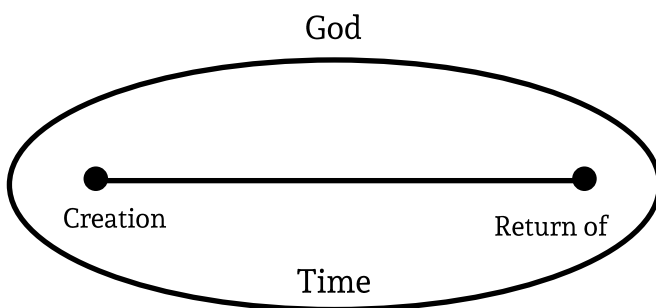
God's eternity is significant for many reasons:
